Sheffield Avenue There will be traffic lane shifts on W. Sheffield Avenue. The parking lanes on both sides of N. Sheffield Avenue just north and south of W. Roscoe Street will be closed. The sidewalk on the east side of N. Sheffield Avenue within the work zone will be closed. The sidewalk on the west side of N. Sheffield Avenue within the work zone will be closed.
