Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. Location: The alley east of the following addresses will be closed:

- 3433 – 3457 N. Sheffield Avenue
- 947 – 957 W. Cornelia Avenue

Work Hours: 7am – 7pm; **continuous 24/7 alley closure**

Work Activity: Micropile Drilling & Foundation Installation

Local Impact:

- The alley will be closed to through traffic at all times.
- **The sidewalk underneath the CTA tracks on the north side of Newport Avenue will be closed.**
- Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces..
- If you need further information about alternative parking, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at 708-253-9772.
- The contractor will maintain garbage and recycling pickup.
- There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from excavation, pile driving, and pouring
 - Loud noise and vibration from driving sheet pile
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
