We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED ALLEY CLOSURE

- Dates:** Weekdays & Saturdays
Wednesday, November 6 to Wednesday, November 20, 2024
- Location:** The north/south alley between:
930 – 936 W. Roscoe Avenue
(W. Roscoe Street to W. Newport Avenue)
- Work Hours:** 7am to 7pm; continuous (24/7) alley closure
- Work Activity:** Alley Reconstruction
- Local Impact:**
- The north/south alley between 930 – 936 W. Roscoe Street will be closed.
 - Vehicles will be unable to enter/exit garages and parking spaces in the alley between 930 – 936 W. Roscoe Street during this closure
 - ***For your safety, please do not attempt to use the alley for any purpose unless in an emergency situation.***
 - Contractor will provide alternative parking for residents with dedicated private parking accessed via the alleyway. If you need further information about alternative parking, please contact the contractor, Walsh-Fluor, at cpoole@walshgroup.com
 - Access to the garage at 937 W. Newport Avenue will be maintained via the recently opened alley entrance on W. Newport Avenue.
 - Access to the east/west alley behind 815 – 933 W. Newport Avenue & 814 – 928 W. Roscoe Street will be maintained via the alley entrances just west of N. Halsted Street.
 - Garbage and recycling bins for 934 – 936 W. Roscoe Street will be relocated to W. Roscoe Street by the contractor until the work activity is complete. Please dispose of garbage and recycling in your relocated bins located on W. Roscoe Street until the alley is reopened and the contractor has moved bins back.
 - There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Loud noise from pavement demolition
 - Beeping for backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
