Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

EXTENDED STREET CLOSURE

Dates: Monday, October 3 to Friday, October 7, 2022

Location: - N. Sheffield Avenue between 3351 N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Clark Street

- W. Roscoe Street between 1009 W. Roscoe Street and N. Clark Street

Work Hours: 7am – 7pm, continuous 24/7 street closure

Work Activity: Track Structure Rehabilitation & Underground Utility Relocation

Local Impact:

- N. Sheffield Avenue between 3351 N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Clark Street will be closed to vehicular and bicycle traffic.
- W. Roscoe Street between 1009 W. Roscoe Street and N. Clark Street will be closed to vehicular and bicycle traffic.
- The street closure will be set-up between the hours of 12am-5am Sunday night into Monday morning.
- N. Sheffield Avenue will be open to local traffic from W. School Street north to 3351 N. Sheffield Avenue.
- Sidewalks within the work zone on N. Sheffield Avenue & W. Roscoe Street will be closed as needed.
- One sidewalk on N. Sheffield Avenue & W. Roscoe Street will remain open at all times.
- N. Kenmore Avenue will be a two-way street (northbound & southbound traffic lanes) between W. Roscoe Street and W. School Street.
- The contractor will maintain access to businesses and residences.
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - Running air compressors and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Use of rivet removal equipment
 - Beeping from backu
