TRAFFIC LANE/SIDEWALK IMPACTS & INTERMITTENT TRAFFIC STOPS

- Dates:**
- **Monday, February 27, 2023**
 - **Tuesday, February 28, 2023 (backup date)**
(If work does not take place on Monday it will take place on Tuesday)
- Location:** W. School Street, between N. Sheffield Avenue and N. Wilton Avenue
- Work Hours:**
- **7am to 3pm**
 - **Intermittent traffic lane stops will take place between 10:30am to 12:30pm**
- Work Activity:** Crane Lifts
- Local Impact:**
- The parking lane on both sides of W. School Street will be closed continuously (24/7) until the work is completed.
 - There will be traffic lane shifts with flagger assistance on W. School Street.
 - **Due to safety concerns, there will be intermittent traffic stops on W. School Street when crane lifts are taking place.**
 - Sidewalk closures within the work zone, underneath the CTA tracks will alternate between the north and south sides of W. School Street.
 - One sidewalk will remain open with flagger assistance when necessary.
 - There will be noise while work is being performed, including:
 - General construction noise
 - Noise from crane lifting and setting equipment
 - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
