

Construction Activity Notice

We are continuing construction on the Red and Purple Modernization (RPM) Phase One project to rebuild 100 year old rail infrastructure and improve transit service. Work will be performed that will affect your community and create inconveniences. We are committed to doing our best to minimize the impact of our work and will continue to keep you updated throughout the project.

Extended Street Closure

Dates: Monday, May 2 to Friday, May 6, 2022

Location: W. School Street, between the CTA tracks and N. Wilton Avenue

Work Hours: 7am to 7pm, **continuous 24/7 street & alley closure**

Work Activity: Track Structure Demolition

Local Impact:

- W. School Street between the CTA tracks and N. Wilton Avenue will be closed to vehicular and bicycle traffic.
- **The street closure will be set-up between the hours of 12am-5am Thursday night into Friday morning.**
- Sidewalk closures within the work zone, underneath the CTA tracks will alternate between the north and south sides of W. School Street.
- One sidewalk will remain open with flagger assistance when necessary. *(The contractor will close the sidewalk if it is deemed unsafe).*
- **N. Wilton Avenue will be northbound only between W. School Street and W. Belmont Avenue**
- There will be noise while work is being performed. Noise will include:
 - General construction noise
 - Loud noise from track structure demolition
 - Running air compressors, excavators, and generators
 - Use of pneumatic and gas/impact tools
 - Beeping for backup alarms on maintenance equipment and vehicles
 - Flagging horns
