Effective, **Monday, August 12, 2019** applications for future Pre-Apprentice "CONCRETE FOR BUILDER" carpentry training classes will be accepted at the **Apprentice Program Office, 1256 Estes Avenue, Elk Grove Village, IL Monday thru Friday, 9:30am to 4:00pm, NO LATER THAN Thursday, September 12, 2019.**

Each Candidate **MUST PRESENT** the following requirements at the Apprentice Program Office:

Minimum Qualifications:

- Letter of recommendation on a Local Union letterhead, signed by and officer
- Must have attained the age of 17 (Driver's License or State I.D. Card required)
- Copy of High School Diploma or High School Transcripts (must have official school seal - 8 credits minimum), or copy of G.E.D Certification
- Copy of Social Security Card or receipt showing duplicate card has been applied for
- A \$25.00 "Non-Refundable" Application Processing Fee (MONEY ORDERS & CASHIERS CHECK ONLY) - No Cash/ No Personal Checks.

All (5) above -listed requirements **MUST BE** submitted at the time of filing or candidate will **NOT** be permitted to file an application. (* Veterans Only - Form DD214 must also be submitted)
