- Additional traffic issues need to be addressed with proposed right of way going to CTA. There will also be additional vehicles being utilized to begin the shuttle service to proposed new destinations.
- More Chicago Police Department members will need to be rail certified with the proximity of the rail system to the designated patrol areas.
- Proposed expansion of the 95th St terminal poses many traffic and security issues. Currently the terminal is one of the busiest rail locations for police service. This would be greatly affected by reduced parking and increased foot and vehicular traffic.

Of particular concern to DOE are issues relating to neighborhood compatibility and environmental justice, primarily in relation to historical and/or privately owned parcels that may need to be acquired for the project. DOE would also be interested in a detailed evaluation of noise and vibration, including additive effects associated with Midway airport operations, to determine how such issues will affect neighboring properties.

For both projects, the City of Chicago's Department of Streets and Sanitation (DSS) would like the review committee to consider the following comments and concerns regarding the expansions during the environmental review process:

- 1. The location of any street lights that will need to be removed or relocated as a result of the new lines;
- An analysis of the affect these elevated concrete supports will have on street level lighting and any steps that will be taken to supplement street lighting in these areas, i.e. CTA-provided lighting on the underside of the elevated line;
- 3. The location of any public way trees that will need to be removed as a result of the new lines or the construction activity and a replacement strategy for those lost trees;

Reference is made to your interagency scoping meeting on September 24, 2009, concerning the subject matter. The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (District) has the following comments for the scoping process:

- Aerial photos of the Locally Preferred Alternative shown at the meeting indicate the
 proposed alignment running along the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) at grade adjacent
 to District property. The District requires access between the Calumet Water
 Reclamation Plant to the west of Cottage Grove Avenue and its facilities to the east of
 Cottage Grove Avenue. District access between the two facilities will have to be
 modified or reconstructed as part of the project.
- The proposed alternative for the station at the end of the line south of 130th Street is adjacent to District property between 130th Street and 130th Avenue and west of the station. Depending on the location of parking, etc., a request to lease or acquire District property may be required.
- The location for the proposed CTA station north of 130th Street is entirely on District property, some of which may be considered wetland. Also, it appears that the rerouted Cottage Grove Avenue utilizes the District road within the plant boundaries. The District understands that the draft plans are preliminary, but we will have to do a complete evaluation as plans are further developed to determine potential impact on the District.

- We recommend an odor study be conducted early in the environmental review process for impacts on the proposed CTA facilities. The area of greatest concern is the final CTA station along 130th Street, which is directly adjacent to the Calumet Water Reclamation Plant.
- The proposed alignment crosses the District's 17'6"x14'0" Calumet Intercepting Sewer 6 just east of Indiana Avenue. Attached are Sheets 1 and 5 of this contract. This intercepting sewer should be placed on all future Red Line Extension plans.
