              MR. MCKONE: Thank you. Good morning,

    Directors. Okay, give me a moment, to share the
    presentation, and then we'll get started. Let's

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Okay, so I'm going to be reporting notes for

    the month of January. This will be a slightly
    shorter report because it's the first month of the
3
    year, so we won't have year-to-date results
4
5
    because they'd be the same as the month-to-date
6
    results.

               Okay, so looking at revenues. Revenues
8
     from fares and passes came in slightly better than
9
    budget and about a million dollars better than
10
     last year, so good results on fare and passes in
    the month of January.
11

               On the non-fare box side of things,
13
    positive results to budget end of last year.
14
    That's primarily driven by our interest, our
15
     investment income there with a larger balance, and
16
     then also it's higher interest rates in the month
17
    of January. So total revenue for the month,
18
     2.3 million positive to budget, 3 million better
    than where we were last year. So good start to
19
20
    the year in January.

               On the expenses side of things, you will
22
    see positive variances there. Labor is positive
23
    to budget. That's driven by a few vacancies and
2.4
    non-service areas. Material positive to budget.
```

1 We're seeing some of the benefits of those -- the 2 newer rail fleet, and having the newer rail fleet out there and reducing our material expenditure, 3 4 especially on the rail vehicle materials. Fuel 5 and power coming in positive to budget primarily 6 because we have better rates on that. So we have 7 better rates on fuel and power. We do anticipate 8 that positive variance to continue throughout the 9 year because of those positive rates as long as 10 our usage stays on track. 11 Injuries and damages, we're taking that 12 expense to budget. Security services, the budgeted amount is consistent with our spend and 13 what's within the 2025 budget. You'll see we're 14 15 slightly positive to budget. I do think that's --16 it will come closer to budget next month there, 17 but it's a good trend to see those security 18 services coming in under budget to start the year with. 19 20 Other expenses, we're catching up on invoices there for a lot of our contractual 2.1

services, so a lot of that is due to timing, and I

think in February you'll see that even out

year-to-date. So total overall operating

              So, a good way to start the year.
               On the public funding side of things,

     I'll present the monthly results first. So you
6
    can see here sales tax and the associated match
7
    coming in better than budget. Real estate
8
    transfer tax slightly below budget, but a little
9
    bit better than we have seen in prior months.
10
    Overall for the month, 4.3 million better on the
11
    public funding than we had in our projections.
12
               Aggregate results for 2024, we are
     three months in a rear on the sales tax, so we're
13
    going to show this for another month as we
14
15
     finalize our 2024 public funding collections.
16
    can see here we're coming in right now about
17
     $15 million favorable to budget for 2024, and then
18
     starting off the year 2025 coming in 6.3 million
     favorable to budget, a lot of that driven by the
19
    match associated with the sales tax revenue.

               On the commodity side of things, nothing
22
    has changed here, although we do expect our
23
    hedging amount for fuel to increase next month as
2.4
    we've seen some positive movement in the price of
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1
    diesel fuel and looking to lock that in for next
2
    year. In addition, we have our power purchase.
3
    Our RFP is out street right now, so we are looking
4
     forward to locking that in. We haven't done so
5
    yet, so our 2026 power remains yet unpurchased.
6

17	concession space, the tenant paying an initial
18	annual rent of \$26 per square foot for a base term
19	of ten years, two five-year options to extend
20	annual rent escalations of 3 percent. Donut Dudes
21	will operate the space as a donut, coffee, grocery
22	convenience store. Total annual rent for the
23	first year from the lease is projected at
24	\$6,525.96. I'd be happy to take any questions on

3	\$38.83 per square foot for a base term of
4	five years with one five-year option to extend in
5	an annual rent escalation of 3 percent. Kisbi
6	will operate the space as an independently branded
7	coffee shop. Total annual rent for the first year
8	from the lease is projected at \$9,000. I'll be
9	happy to take any questions on this item.

13	as a director of diversity programs at the CTA.
14	This change order is for our diversity management
15	system called B2Gnow, and also our legal
16	compliance system called LCPtracker. These are
17	two systems of record that we use for our DBE and
18	SBE program and for labor compliance.
19	So in B2G we certify DBEs and SPEs; we
20	conduct outreach through it; evaluate the
21	proposals when they come in for their DBE plans;
22	and then also monitor the contracts through B2G.
23	On the LCPtracker system we collect
24	certified payrolls on construction projects so

1	that we can make sure the contractors are	
2	compliant with the Prevailing Wage Act and the	
3	Davis-Bacon Act.
