


RPM Phase One: Overview

What is a neighborhood identifier?

- Each stationhouse (Lawrence, Argyle, Berwyn and Bryn Mawr) will feature unique "identifier" artistic elements
- The identifiers, with the community's help, will represent the neighborhood and enhance the stations for the community.
- The identifiers are in addition to and separate from previously announced artwork for each of the new stations.




