## NOW AND FUTURE

### LOOK AT NOW AND WHAT TO EXPECT IN THE FUTURE:

- Riders: more reliable train service, less crowding and fewer delays
- Dramatic improvement to pedestrian experience under CTA right of way – brighter, cleaner and more aesthetically pleasing structures
- Communities benefit from proximity to transit with increased property values and business growth and resiliency
- New paving in certain areas under CTA structure
- Better drainage systems
- Less noise, closed deck bridge for reduced overhead train noise
- Improved alley access for residents and loading zone needs
