



CTA Rider Suspensions Pursuant to the MTA Act (70 ILCS 3605/31) and RTA Act (70 ILCS 3615/2.40)

2024 Quarter 1 (January-March)

- On January 18, 2024, the Chicago Transit Board passed Board Ordinance No. 024-2, which amended CTA's Rules of Conduct to establish a rider suspension process consistent with the requirements of Section 2.40 of the RTA Act and Section 31 of the MTA Act.
- During the first quarter of 2024, CTA continued to work with the Chicago Police Department and Cook County State's Attorney's Office to request and obtain judicial orders of suspension.
