



Flag Stops in Evanston

Although some stops in Evanston are marked with bus stop signs, areas without posted stops operate by "flag stop". **In Evanston**, passengers can board or exit the bus at any intersection along the route where it is safe to do so. To board at a flag stop, wait at a corner where a bus driver can see you and flag the bus as it approaches.

Supplementary service may be provided over portions of this route in addition to the trips shown. Please check destination signs and announcements when boarding buses.
