

ORDINANCE NO. 026-94

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
A CHANGE ORDER TO A
CONTRACT WITH SOUTH
SUBURBAN PEST CONTROL
FOR EXTERMINATION
SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") requires extermination services to maintain buses that are free of pests; and

WHEREAS, On September 21, 2023, the Authority entered into a contract with South Suburban Pest Control under Requisition No. B22OP01037R for the extermination services for thirty-six months, the contract was extended for six months by letter, and Change Order No. 1 added funds in the amount of \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS, The Authority's bus fleet has increased from 1800 to 2000 buses and Staff is requesting Change Order No. 2 to add funds to the contract in the amount of \$27,500.00 to cover the increased treatment; and

WHEREAS, Change orders for contracts originally valued at \$1,000,000.00 or less that individually or cumulatively increase the original contract value by more than 10% require approval by the Transit Board; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of Change Order No. 2 to the contract with South Suburban Pest Control for extermination services to add funds in the amount of \$27,500.00; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President or Acting President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute Change Order No. 2 to the contract with South Suburban Pest Control for extermination services to add funds in the amount of Twenty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$27,500.00) for a revised contract amount of Three Hundred Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$302,500.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, President or Acting President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.
