ORDINANCE NO. 019-27

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE CONTRACT WITH TRAPEZE SOFTWARE GROUP, INC. FOR SOFTWARE LICENSES. MAINTENANCE. SUPPORT. ENHANCEMENTS AND UPGRADES FOR MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM INFORMATION (MMIS), TRANSIT OPERATIONS PLANNING SYSTEM (TOPS) AND BUS FUEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (BFMS)

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") uses the Maintenance Management Information System (MMIS), Transit Operations Planning System (TOPS) and Bus Fuel Management System (BFMS) software applications provided by Trapeze Software Group, Inc. ("Trapeze"); and

WHEREAS, The Authority requires continued use, maintenance, support, enhancements, and upgrades of these Trapeze software systems and wishes to consolidate multiple contracts with Trapeze into one contract; and

WHEREAS, Trapeze owns the software applications and is the only vendor authorized to provide the required maintenance, support, enhancements, and upgrades so advertising for bids would serve no useful purpose and would not be in the best interests of the Authority or the public; and

WHEREAS, Section 1.4A of the Authority's Procurement Policy and Procedures provides for the award of contracts without competitive bidding "where the goods or services to be procured are procurable from only one source"; and

WHEREAS, This procurement was reviewed and approved by the Authority's Sole Source/Disadvantageous Review Committee following no other vendor responses to its advertisement on the Authority's website for a period of three weeks; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends award of a sole source contract under Requisition No. B19FT04576 to Trapeze for licenses, maintenance, support, enhancements, and upgrades of Trapeze software applications for a term of five (5) years with two (2) funded one-year options in an amount not to exceed Eighteen Million Four Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Twenty Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents (\$18,486,420.67); now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

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SECTION 1: Based on the statements set forth in the recitals of this ordinance, the Chicago Transit Board hereby determines that the goods and services being procured are procurable from only one source.

SECTION 2: The Chairman of the Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Trapeze Software Group, Inc. for licenses, maintenance, support, enhancements, and upgrades of Trapeze software applications for a term of five (5) years with two (2) funded one-year options in an amount not to exceed Eighteen Million Four Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Twenty Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents (\$18,486,420.67).

SECTION 3. The Chairman, or his designee, is further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
