

ORDINANCE NO. 019-30

AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING THE  
DISCHARGE OF KERMITT E.  
COLLINS

WHEREAS, following his discharge from the Chicago Transit Authority, Kermitt E. Collins requested a hearing pursuant to Section 28 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 88-81, as amended, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board appointed a Hearing Committee to conduct a hearing; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on October 25<sup>th</sup> and November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018, and

WHEREAS, the Chicago Transit Board reviewed and considered the Hearing Committee's recommendation; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The report of the Hearing Committee appointed to conduct a hearing on the Complaint of Kermitt E. Collins, together with the transcript of the proceedings, post-hearing briefs and exhibits, shall be made a part of the minutes of the April 10, 2019 Executive Session of the Chicago Transit Board.

SECTION 2. The Section 28 Complaint filed by Kermitt E. Collins following his discharge on September 21, 2018, is hereby dismissed. Kermitt E. Collins' discharge is sustained.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
