

ORDINANCE NO. 019-37

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING  
THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT  
TO AGB INVESTIGATIVE  
SERVICES, INC. FOR  
SECURITY GUARD SERVICES  
WITH CANINES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority (“Authority”) needs security guard services with canines for its rail system and other properties; and

WHEREAS, The Authority issued an Invitation for Bid under Requisition No. B18OP80021 and AGB Investigative Services, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive bid and is a responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, The contract provides for security guards with canines, supervisors, radios, a guard-monitoring system, and vehicles to enable a highly-visible and mobile security presence on the Authority’s rail system and properties; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends award of a contract to AGB Investigative Services, Inc. for security guard services with canines for a term of two years with two unfunded one-year options in an amount not to exceed Fourteen Million Dollars (\$14,000,000.00); now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract with AGB Investigative Services, Inc. for security guard services with canines for a term of two years with two unfunded one-year options in an amount not to exceed Fourteen Million Dollars (\$14,000,000.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, or his designee, is further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
