

ORDINANCE NO. 019-96

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
CONTRACT WITH PROTANIC, INC.
FOR SERVICE, TESTING, REPAIR,
PARTS AND CALIBRATION FOR
UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") has approximately sixty (60) underground storage tanks containing diesel fuel, gasoline, engine oil, torque oil, and antifreeze which require servicing, testing, repair, parts, and calibration to ensure that they comply with environmental regulations; and

WHEREAS, The Authority issued an Invitation for Bids under Requisition No. B19OP80668R for servicing, testing, repair, parts, and calibration for the underground storage tanks, and Protanic, Inc. ("Protanic") submitted the lowest responsive bid and is a responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, Protanic has certified that the prices quoted to the Authority are "equal to" or "not greater than" prices currently quoted to Protanic's most-favored customers; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends award of a contract to Protanic for servicing, testing, repair, parts, and calibration for underground storage tanks for a term of thirty-six (36) months in an amount not to exceed Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00); now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Protanic, Inc. for servicing, testing, repair, parts, and calibration for underground storage tanks for a term of thirty-six (36) months in an amount not to exceed Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, or his designee, is further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
