ORDINANCE NO. 020-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACTS TO A POOL OF ELEVEN FIRMS FOR TEMPORARY STAFFING SERVICES ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") requires temporary staffing services to assist various departments on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, The Authority issued a Request for Proposals under Requisition No. B19OP04347 seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide the temporary staffing services, and the proposals of eleven firms were determined to be advantageous to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, Individual task orders will be awarded from this pool of eleven firms based on evaluations by the Project Manager and General Manager or Director of the user department and other authorized Authority designees of the qualifications of the personnel submitted by the firm as well as the price quoted for the project; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends award of contracts to the eleven firms listed in Section 1 below for temporary staffing services on an as-needed basis for a term of three years with one funded one-year option for a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$1,200,000.00; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute contracts with Anchor Staffing, Inc. (DBE), 22nd Century Technologies, Inc., Abacus Service Corp., Banner Personnel, Cogent Infotech Corp., Dataman USA LLC, Howroyd-Wright Employment Agency, Inc. d/b/a Apple One Employment Services, LanceSoft Inc., Premier Staffing Source, Inc., VIVA USA Inc. (DBE), and Vtech Solution for temporary staffing services on an as-needed basis for a term of three (3) years with one (1) funded one-year option for a total aggregate amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, or his designee, is further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
