

ORDINANCE NO. 020-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
A CONTRACT WITH T.Y. LIN
INTERNATIONAL GREAT LAKES,
INC. FOR ENVIRONMENTAL
DOCUMENTATION AND
PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING
SERVICES FOR THE RED LINE
EXTENSION (RLE) PROJECT

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") is undertaking a project to extend the Red Line from the existing 95th/Dan Ryan terminal to 130th Street and add four new stations, also known as the Red Line Extension ("RLE") Project; and

WHEREAS, The Authority issued Letters of Interest & Qualifications (LIQ) under Requisition No. C19FC102326216 for the environmental documentation and Preliminary Engineering Services for the RLE Project, including a Final Environmental Impact Statement and Record of Decision, and determined that T.Y. Lin International Great Lakes, Inc. ("T.Y. Lin") is the most qualified proposer; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends award of a contract to T.Y. Lin for the required services for a term of three years with six unfunded one-year options for an amount not to exceed \$37,324,821.00 plus an additional \$1,000,000.00 for necessary but unforeseen amendments; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with T.Y. Lin International Great Lakes, Inc. for environmental documentation and Preliminary Engineering services for the Red Line Extension Project for a term of three (3) years with six (6) unfunded one-year options for an amount not to exceed Thirty-Seven Million Three Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$37,324,821.00), plus an additional One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for necessary but unforeseen amendments.

SECTION 2. The Chairman, or his designee, is further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
