

ORDINANCE NO. 020-24

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
A CONTRACT WITH JONES
ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL,
INC. FOR INSPECTION,
REPAIR, MAINTENANCE, AND
REBUILDING OF BOILERS

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") requires inspection, maintenance, repair, and rebuilding of boilers, as well as burner and control upgrades and building automation system upgrades at various locations; and

WHEREAS, The Authority issued an Invitation for Bids under Requisition No. B19OP00636 for the required services, and Jones Environmental Control, Inc. submitted the lowest responsive bid and is a responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends award of a contract to Jones Environmental Control, Inc. for inspection, maintenance, repair, and rebuilding of boilers, as well as burner and control upgrades and building automation system upgrades at various locations, for a term of three years with two unfunded one-year options for an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000.00; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Jones Environmental Control, Inc. for inspection, maintenance, repair, and rebuilding of boilers, as well as burner and control upgrades and building automation system upgrades at various locations, for a term of three (3) years with two (2) unfunded one-year options for an amount not to exceed Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, or his designee, is further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
