

ORDINANCE NO. 020-84

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR
CONTRACT NO. B12OP04206 WITH
GENUINE PARTS COMPANY D/B/A
NAPA

WHEREAS, On November 14, 2012, the Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") awarded Contract No. B12OP04206 to Genuine Parts Company d/b/a NAPA for procurement of vehicle, facilities, and infrastructure parts and supply chain services for a five-year term with one three-year option to extend; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board approval, Ordinance No. 012-147, included funding for the base five-year contract period only, in the not-to-exceed sum of Three Hundred Fifty Million Dollars (\$350,000,000.00); and

WHEREAS, The actual total spend for the base five-year contract period was Two Hundred Fifty Million Dollars (\$250,000,000.00); and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board approved, per Ordinance No. 017-88, an additional One Hundred Million Dollars (\$100,000,000.00) for the contract option period; and

WHEREAS, An additional Twenty-Two Million Dollars (\$22,000,000.00) is needed to ensure adequate funding through the contract period, as the contract was prematurely expended due to several factors including Covid-19 related supplies and equipment; and

WHEREAS, NAPA has committed to maintaining a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 26% in the three-year option period; and

WHEREAS, Chicago Transit Board approval is required to add funding to the contract; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chicago Transit Board hereby approves the addition of funding to Contract No. B12OP04206 with NAPA in the amount of Twenty-Two Million Dollars (\$22,000,000.00) for a total not-to-exceed contract amount of Four Hundred Seventy-Two Million Dollars (\$472,000,000.00) over the eight-year term.

SECTION 2. The Vice Chair of the Chicago Transit Board, or her designee, is authorized, pursuant to Section 7 of the Chicago Transit Authority Bylaws, Rules and Regulations and Rules of Order due to the absence of a Board Chair, to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
