

ORDINANCE NO. 021-9

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A  
CHANGE ORDER TO A CONTRACT  
WITH TALENTCLICK INC. FOR  
PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING  
HIRING ASSESSMENT SERVICES TO  
ADD FUNDING

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority's ("Authority") Human Resources Department requires employment for hiring assessments to select top employees for Transit Operator and Customer Assistant positions to ensure safety and customer service; and

WHEREAS, On October 30, 2019, the Authority entered into a contract with TalentClick Inc. under Requisition No. C19OP102318436 for the required employment hiring assessment services for a term of twelve (12) months in an amount of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00); and

WHEREAS, The Authority extended the contract for six (6) months by letter and now requests authorization for additional funding for the time extension; and

WHEREAS, Contract change orders that individually or cumulatively increase the original contract value by more than 10% or extend the termination date by more than twelve months require approval by the Transit Board; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of Change Order No. 1 to the contract with TalentClick Inc. for employment hiring assessment services to add \$39,077.50 in additional funding; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Vice Chair of the Chicago Transit Board, or her designee, pursuant to Section 7 of the Chicago Transit Authority Bylaws, Rules and Regulations and Rules of Order due to the absence of a Board Chair, and the President of the Chicago Transit Authority and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute Change Order No. 1 to the Authority's contract with TalentClick Inc. for employment hiring assessment services to add Thirty-Nine Thousand Seventy-Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$39,077.50) in additional funding for a revised contract amount of One Hundred Nineteen Thousand Seventy-Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$119,077.50).

SECTION 2. The Vice Chair, President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.
