

ORDINANCE NO. 021-21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING  
CONTRACTS FOR MATERIALS,  
LABOR, EQUIPMENT AND  
SUPPLIES--PUBLIC BIDDING

WHEREAS, Pursuant to advertisements duly published in accordance with statutory requirements, the Chicago Transit Authority has received bids for furnishing certain requirements as set forth in the following schedule indicating the lowest responsive and responsible bidders; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Vice Chair of the Chicago Transit Board, or her designee, pursuant to Section 7 of the Chicago Transit Authority Bylaws, Rules and Regulations, and the President of the Chicago Transit Authority and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to enter into contracts with the following named bidders for requirements as set forth in the respective requisitions:
