ORDINANCE NO. 90-192

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MODIFICATION OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND THE AMALGAMATED TRANSIT UNION, THE TEAMSTERS UNION, THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS AND THE UNIONS COMPRISING THE METAL TRADES COUNCIL FOR THE PERIOD DECEMBER 1, 1989 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1992

BE IT ORDAINED BY CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute collective bargaining agreements relating to wages, hours and working conditions with the Unions identified in Section 2 of this ordinance for the period from December 1, 1989 to December 31, 1992, said agreements to be modified in substantially the form attached herete as Exhibit A and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Unions with which the Chairman, or his designee, is authorized to execute the aforesaid collective bargaining agreements are as follows:

International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Locals 9 and 134
