

ORDINANCE NO. 021-100

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
CONTRACT WITH METROPOLITAN
LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY FOR
VISION BENEFIT SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") requires vision benefit services for non-union employees and their dependents; and

WHEREAS, The Authority issued a Request for Proposals under Requisition No. B21OP04727 for qualified firms to provide the required services, and Metropolitan Life Insurance Company's proposal was determined to be most advantageous to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends award of a contract to Metropolitan Life Insurance Company for vision benefit services for up to three years with two funded one-year options to extend for the not-to-exceed amount of \$700,000.00; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute a contract with Metropolitan Life Insurance Company for vision benefit services for up to three (3) years with two (2) funded one-year options for an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
