

ORDINANCE NO. 021-102

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
A CHANGE ORDER TO A
CONTRACT WITH ORACLE
AMERICA, INC. FOR HOSTING
SERVICES FOR BUDGETING
SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") entered into a contract with Oracle America, Inc. ("Oracle") for hosting services for the Authority's budgeting software on August 24, 2012 under Requisition No. B12OP04174 pursuant to Ordinance No. 012-107; and

WHEREAS, The contract with Oracle was amended to extend it for three years, and Change Order Nos. 1-4 extended the contract further and provided additional funding; and

WHEREAS, The Authority issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a new contract for these hosting services, and proposals were received in June 2021; and

WHEREAS, Staff has requested an additional extension of the existing contract to provide sufficient time to complete the RFP procurement process for a new contract, including transition time to a potential new vendor; and

WHEREAS, Contract change orders that individually or cumulatively increase the original contract value by more than 10% or \$500,000 or extend the contract termination date by more than twelve months require approval by the Board; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Board approve Change Order No. 5 to the contract with Oracle for hosting services for budgeting software to extend the contract for twelve months and provide additional funding for the extension period in the amount of \$200,155.00; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute Change Order No. 5 to the contract with Oracle America, Inc. for hosting services for the Authority's budgeting software to extend the term for twelve (12) months and provide additional funding in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$200,155.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.
