AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO A CONTRACT WITH SDI PRESENCE, LLC FOR TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") requires managed technology support services for its network, servers, desktop computers, laptop computers, and helpdesk functions; and

WHEREAS, The Authority entered into a contract with SDI Presence, LLC ("SDI") under Requisition B12OP01324 for the required services; and

WHEREAS, The Transit Board has authorized multiple change orders extending the contract and adding funding, and the contract is set to expire on August 18, 2021; and

WHEREAS, The Authority has issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a new contract for technology support services; and

WHEREAS, Due to the complexity of the services and the number of proposals received in response to the RFP, staff recommends extending the existing contract by an additional nine months and adding \$2,945,000.00 in funds for the extension period; and

WHEREAS, Contract change orders that individually or cumulatively increase the original contract value by more than 10% or by more than \$500,000.00 or extend the termination date by more than twelve months require approval by the Transit Board; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of Change Order No. 4 to the contract with SDI for technology support services to extend the contract by nine months and add \$2,945,000.00 in funds; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute Change Order No. 4 to the Authority's contract with SDI Presence, LLC for technology support services to extend the contract by nine (9) months and add funds in the amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$2,945,000.00).
