

ORDINANCE NO. 023-32

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN  
AMENDMENT TO A CONTRACT  
APPROVED BY THE CHICAGO  
TRANSIT BOARD

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WHEREAS, Contracts originally approved by the Chicago Transit Board now require approval of contract amendments; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President of the Chicago Transit Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute the following contract amendment:

Original Ordinance No. 020-16

Description: *Red Line Extension (RLE) Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and Preliminary Engineering Project.*

This Contract Amendment No. 6 provides for funding for the consultant's additional labor and other direct costs to perform new Task 38.B – Traction Power Guidance Details and 38.C – Mainline Signal System Advanced Design. The scope of services consists of development of traction power wayside installation guidance drawings, development signal system block design, and interim submittals and workshops with CTA. The circumstances said to necessitate the change were not reasonably foreseeable at the time the contract was executed.

**Contract Amendment No. 6: \$1,318,629.00**

**Revised Contract Amount: \$39,641,554.00**

SECTION 2. The Chairman, President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.
