

ORDINANCE NO. 024-103

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
CHANGE ORDER TO A CONTRACT
WITH ALLIED WASTE
TRANSPORTATION INC. D/B/A
REPUBLIC SERVICES OF CHICAGO
FOR WASTE REMOVAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority (“Authority”) requires waste/refuse removal services for Rail Station Management; and

WHEREAS, On August 13, 2019, the Authority entered into a contract with Allied Waste Transportation Inc. d/b/a Republic Services of Chicago under Requisition No. B18OP03734 for the required services for up to thirty-six months two funded one-year options for the not-to-exceed amount of \$4,600,000.00, and Change Order No. 1 added funds in the amount of \$460,000.00; and

WHEREAS, The contract was extended by six months via letter, and staff is requesting additional funding to cover contractual needs until a new contract is in place; and

WHEREAS, Change orders for contracts originally valued at more than \$1,000,000.00 that individually or cumulatively increase the original contract value by more than 10% or \$500,000.00 or extend the original termination date by more than twelve months require approval by the Transit Board; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of Change Order No. 2 to the contract with Allied Waste Transportation Inc. d/b/a Republic Services of Chicago waste/refuse removal services to add \$810,000.00 in additional funds; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute Change Order No. 2 to the Authority’s contract with Allied Waste Transportation Inc. d/b/a Republic Services of Chicago for waste/refuse removal services to add Eight Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$810,000.00) in additional funds, for a revised contract amount of Five Million Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$5,870,000.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

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SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
